

Curbside Pickup Non-Allowable Items

Non-Allowable Items for shall include the following:

- 1. Yard waste such as brush, tree limbs, tree stumps, grass clippings and leaves.
- 2. Tires
- 3. Demolition or construction debris, meaning non-putrescible waste building materials and rubble resulting from the construction, remodeling, repair or demolition of structures.
- 4. Christmas trees, evergreen boughs, and evergreen wreaths.
- 5. Materials set out for recycling. This includes anything in a recycling cart.
- 6. Televisions, computers and electronics.
- 7. Scrap Metal.
- 8. Major Appliances, specifically: stoves, ranges, refrigerators, freezers, washers, dryers, dishwashers, microwave ovens, air conditioners, humidifiers, and dehumidifiers.
- 9. Bulky Items such as furniture, sofas, mattresses, box springs, tables, chairs, desks and bookshelves and carpet from residences, municipal properties and schools
- 10. Sharps/Needles (use the red Sharps Kiosk in the Police Station Lobby for disposal)

Unacceptable Material

Unacceptable Material shall include the following:

- 1. Explosives, pathological and biological waste, chemicals, radioactive materials, oil sludge, highly flammable substances, cesspool or other human waste, human or animal remains, motor vehicles, liquid waste, construction materials and demolition debris.
- 2. Any item of wastes either smoldering, on fire, at its kindling point or in the process of supporting combustion.
- 3. Any hazardous waste including any and all useless, unwanted, discarded substance or material that is listed or considered hazardous waste by the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services, the United States Environmental Protection Agency, any applicable State or Federal law, rule or regulation, or is hazardous because of characteristics of ignitability, corrosiveness, reactivity or toxicity.
