

The Sharps Container has MOVED.

It is now located in the front lobby of the Londonderry Police Station and is available 7 days a week.

Sharps/needles are **NOT** allowed in Londonderry's trash collection.

You must place sharps/needles in a thick walled, sturdy plastic container with a tight fitting screw cap, such as an empty detergent bottle.

Label the container with the words "**Medical Sharps Container, Not for Recycling**".

When about half-full, seal the container with heavy duty tape.

Dispose of the container in the red "Sharps Kiosk" at the Londonderry Police Station.

No single loose sharps/needles are permitted in the kiosk.

PLEASE DO NOT PLACE IN THE TRASH !!!

Fall Collection: Held in the Town of Londonderry

When: November 23, 2024

8:30 AM. - 12:30 PM

Where: LAFA Ball Fields, Sargent Road

What to bring:

Oil Based Paint/Solvents • Pesticides • Herbicides • Poisons • Household Cleaners • Mercury Devices • Automotive Products (no oil) • Pool Chemicals • Corrosives • Acids • Creosote

(NO Water Based Paint. If it can be cleaned with soap and water, Do Not Bring.)



Frequently Asked Questions?

What if I have more trash than will fit in my cart?

All household trash must be inside the green town provided trash cart to be collected. Any items left outside of your trash cart, will not be collected.

If you only have extra household trash occasionally, you can purchase authorized green overflow bags that can be set on top of or beside the trash cart for collection. These bags are available at the Town Hall or Drop Off Center for \$3 per bag.

If you regularly have extra trash, you can contact the Town at (603)432-1100 Ext. 193 and request one of the following options:

- An additional 32-gallon trash cart - \$150 for the initial year issued, \$105 for subsequent years
- An additional 65-gallon trash cart - \$200 for the initial year issued, \$150 for subsequent years
- Waiver of Fee - The fee for an additional trash cart shall be waived for household units that have six (6) or more occupants and for households with medical needs.

What if I have more recycling than will fit in my cart?

If you regularly have extra recyclables, you can contact the Town at (603)432-1100 Ext.193 and request an additional recycling cart for a one time fee of \$47.75. For those households with 6 or more people, a second recycle cart will be free of charge.

Extra recyclables can also be brought to the Drop Off Center at 13 Recovery Way for disposal, open seasonally, April 13 - November 23, 2024 on Saturdays 7:30AM—3:30 PM, and summer hours on Wednesdays from April 17 - Sept. 4, 2024, 3:00 PM—7:00 PM.

What do I do with bulky items that will not fit into the trash cart?

Residents should continue to bring bulky items to the Drop Off Center, 13 Recovery Way, open seasonally, April 13 - November 23, 2024 on Saturdays 7:30AM—3:30 PM, and summer hours on Wednesdays from April 17 - Sept. 4, 2024, 3:00 PM—7:00 PM.

Acceptable Items at the Drop Off Center - no charge:

Yard Waste • Bulk Plastics • Clothing & textiles • Car Batteries • Fluorescent Bulbs • Cell Phones • Extra Household Recycling

Acceptable items at the Drop Off Center - Fee Charged

(NO CASH accepted. Payment is by check or credit card only.*

Scrap Metal • Propane Tanks • Construction Debris • Bulky Items • Furniture • Carpet • Tires • Electronics

Automated Trash and Recycling Collection Services



SCHEDULE:

All trash and recyclables must be placed in the Town provided green trash and blue recycle carts and placed curbside by 7:00 a.m. on your designated collection day.

Waste Management collects trash every week and recycling every other week.

WEEKLY - TRASH (64-gallon green cart):

- All regular household trash must be bagged and placed in the green 64-gallon cart for collection.
- The lid on your cart should be closed and no materials may be left outside of the cart.
- Any waste materials left outside the cart **will not** be collected unless they are in approved green town provided overflow bags which can be purchased for \$3.00 each at the Town Hall or Drop Off Center.
- **DO NOT** place recyclables in the green 64-gallon cart.
- Green overflow bags must be placed on top of or beside the green 64-gallon cart.

The following items will **NOT** be accepted in your trash cart:

- Dirt, sod, yard waste, concrete or rock.
- Construction/demolition debris/wood.
- Household hazardous waste and electronics.
- Hot ashes or flammable materials such as oil, gas, or paint.
- Medical sharps/needles.

BI-WEEKLY - RECYCLING (96-gallon blue cart with either a blue or gray lid):

- Use the blue 96-gallon cart for all recyclables.
- Recycling will be collected EVERY OTHER WEEK on the same day as your trash collection. The lid color of your recycling cart designates your collection week.
 - **Blue** lids will be collected on the **Blue** weeks.
 - **Gray** lids will be collected on the **Gray** weeks as noted in the **"Recycling Bi-weekly Collection Schedule"** on the adjacent panel.
- You do not need to sort your recyclables - see list of **"Acceptable Recyclables"** on the next panel of this brochure.
- Do not place trash, plastic bags, plastic wrap, or anything made of Styrofoam in your recycling cart.
- No sharps/needles should be placed in your recycling cart - see Sharps Information on the back page of this brochure.

ACCEPTABLE RECYCLABLES:

Place all of your recycling loosely in the **blue** recycling cart (no plastic bags in the **blue** recycling cart). Items should be rinsed free of food waste. ANY recyclable item listed below can be combined in your blue recycling container.

Paper:

- Newspaper & catalogs
- Telephone books
- Junk mail & cardboard
- Magazines
- Milk cartons
- Cereal & cracker boxes (wax liners removed)

Corrugated Cardboard:

- Flat & cut down to fit in the container.

Cans:

- Aluminum, steel, & tin cans

Glass:

- Bottles and jars

Rigid Plastics:

- Water & soda bottles
- Laundry detergent, milk & yogurt containers



NO plastic bags / film / wrap • No Trash • No food waste • No Styrofoam • No needles • No tanglers (garden hose, cords, string)

Please note all large plastic items such as children's toys, lawn furniture, and containers should be brought to the Londonderry Drop Off Center, located at 13 Recovery Way for no charge. Open seasonally April - November.

CART PLACEMENT:




The trash/recycle carts shall be placed 3-feet away from the edge of the pavement. Also, keep the cart 3-5 feet from any obstructions (mailboxes, fences, parked cars, trash/recycle cart, etc.)

Please **DO NOT** place the carts in the street where they can impede traffic and interfere with snow plow operations.

Recycling Bi-Weekly Collection Schedule

July 2024 - June 2025



Gray Lid - If you have a gray lid, put your recycling out on the same weekday as your trash but only on the weeks that are colored in gray on the calendar above. (For example: July 8-12 is a gray week.)

Blue Lid - If you have a blue lid, put your recycling out on the same weekday as your trash but only on the weeks that are colored in blue on the calendar above. (For example: July 15-19 is a blue week.)

Holidays - If your collection falls on or after a holiday marked in yellow on the calendar above, your collection will be delayed by one day for the remainder of the week. (For example: During the week of May 26, 2025, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday will all be delayed by one day. Monday's pickup will be on Tuesday, Tuesday's pickup will be on Wednesday, Wednesday's pickup will be on Thursday, Thursday's pickup will be on Friday and Friday's pickup will be on Saturday.)
